I am reminding the court of the pain, anger, grief and huge financial expense your behavior has brought to first responders, the AG office, the judge and criminal justice employees, the fire departments, the police man who risked his life pulling you over in traffic at night, the attorneys, the warden service, life flight, the secretaries and assistants, the home owners on the lake, the funeral home, the friends of Kristen, my family, Nate, his family and myself. Kristen lost everything. She suffered and died aware of her impending death.

The painful emails, text messages and outcries, the choices all of these people and my family had to make about what to do about you and your behavior. The horrific night of August 2nd and again to be revisited with your escapade last month is over. We are all permanently scared and the state taxpayers are out thousands and thousands of dollars.

I am asking one thing from you. Please when you are finished the time served leave the state of Maine forever. On my first victims testimony I asked to to continue Kristen's work. Fix somebody's plumbing, save a dog, volunteer. You completed 0 hours in two years and continued your reckless behavior. This time the only way all of us can rest and be assured your name will never be in our inboxes, our papers, our restless nights is for you to leave.

We will do Kristen's work. I hope you do make your family proud some day. We all have paid and paid and paid. Not one penny of restitution, not one minute of Kristen's work came from you personally.
